

Or just relax at your hotel in preparation for the explorations of the islands that begin tomorrow.

# Santa Cruz Island - Immersion in Nature's Grandeur

After fueling up for adventure, you'll take flight to the enchanted Galapagos Islands, to begin your immersion in nature's grandeur on Santa Cruz Island. A scenic footpath overlooks Academy Bay to the renowned Charles Darwin Research Center. Your expert team of guides use this as terrific opportunity to share with you their passion and knowledge of the incredible species that have called these islands home for millennia, including the giant Galapagos tortoise and Darwin's beloved finches.

Then, it's time to take to the waters as you kayak through the lava channel walls of Divine Bay, aptly named for its crystal-clear, tranquil waters. Keep your eyes peeled for stingrays, blue-footed boobies, lava gulls, and herons as you paddle alongside these remarkable creatures in their natural habitat. After docking, walk a beach-side footpath, perhaps pausing for a refreshing dip in a picturesque swimming hole before arriving at your boutique waterfront hotel, your well-appointed basecamp for the adventures ahead.

#### DAY 3 »

### Santa Fe Island - A Wildlife Immersion Like No Other

From Santa Cruz, your cinematic view stretches to Santa Fe, the oldest and most pristine of the Galapagos islands at four million years old. This remarkable isle is home to endemic species found nowhere else on Earth, including the Santa Fe land iguana and groves of Opuntia cactus that resemble prickly, paddle-shaped trees.

Join your naturalist guide for a day of snorkeling, beachside barbecues, and unforgettable

wildlife encounters. Immerse yourself in a world where sea lions bask on the shores, sea turtles glide gracefully beneath the surface, and Galapagos hawks and Nazca boobies soar overhead. This is a true wildlife immersion, offering countless opportunities to interact with the incredible biodiversity that has made the Galapagos famous worldwide.

In the afternoon, your captain navigates the boat to the secluded Playa Escondida, a beautiful and isolated beach accessible only by water. Here, your guides will lead you on a naturalist walk to spot blue-footed boobies, Sally Lightfoot crabs, and more. Then, plunge back into the turquoise waters to snorkel alongside spotted eagle rays, golden rays, sea turtles, and even the elusive white-tipped shark that calls this pristine area home.

#### Regenerative Travel: Witnessing the Galápagos Through the Eyes of a Local

#### DAY 4 »

### Santa Cruz Highlands - Walking Among Giants

This morning, you'll have the remarkable opportunity to walk among some of the oldest inhabitants of the Galapagos – the giant tortoises. These ancient creatures can grow up to 500 pounds and live for an astonishing 175 years or more. Follow your guides along a scenic woodland trail to a peaceful watering hole, the natural habitat of these gentle giants, in a way that is truly 'only with Classic Journeys.'

While cruise ship passengers are limited to crowded coastal sites, you'll venture deep into the highlands, where it's just you and a couple of dozen tortoises in their undisturbed environment.

With no fences or barriers separating you from these amazing creatures, your naturalist guides ensure you get close enough to hear their gentle breaths and the sound of them chomping on grass - a close encounter like no other.

After this unforgettable experience, you'll visit the family-owned plantation of our friend Adrianno. Here, you'll spend time with the family, learning about their organic, sustainable operation and tasting the delicious coffee, sugar cane, and fruit grown on the property in the same rich volcanic soil that's also favored by the animals.

# Isabela Island - Unveiling Nature's Wonders

This morning, you'll transfer to Isabela, the largest and youngest of the Galapagos Islands at just one million years old. Straddling the equator, this remarkable isle offers no shortage of wildlife sightings from the moment you arrive. In the afternoon, you'll experience two incredible ways to get up close and personal with the amazing creatures that call Isabela home.

First, enjoy a scenic, naturalist-guided walk along the mangroves and wetlands, home to spectacular pink flamingos, iguanas the color of the black lava rocks, and an incredible variety of migratory birds. Then, it's time to search for wildlife beneath the surface as you walk to a quiet cove and snorkel in the turquoise waters. Here, you'll have the unforgettable chance to swim alongside playful sea lions, graceful green sea turtles, and curious marine iguanas. Relax in the pristine bay of Concha y Perla, keeping your eyes peeled for blue-footed boobies perched in the trees along the shores, and watch in awe as they hover over the sea and dive for fish.

As the evening approaches and cruise passengers zodiac back to their ships, you'll be walking back to your beachside boutique hotel, your sanctuary on the shores of this remarkable island.

DAY 6 »

# Volcan Sierra Negra - Walking on Mars

The Galapagos Islands are among the most volcanically active spots on Earth, and Isabela was formed by the merger of six massive volcanoes. Today, you'll experience this volcanic terrain firsthand as you get an up-close look at how millennia of eruptions and lava flows have shaped the unique Galapagos habitat.

Your morning walk along the rim of the 500,000-year-old Volcan Sierra Negra will be an experience you'll never forget. From this vantage point, you'll be treated to one of the most spectacular views in the islands, gazing into the six-mile-wide crater – one of the largest active calderas on the planet. With its orange, red, and yellow lava formations and puffing fumaroles, your guides will show you how this otherworldly landscape is more akin to walking on Mars than Earth.

Despite the volcanic origins, the island is surprisingly lush at this altitude, with verdant ferns, papaya trees, and angel's trumpets (with blossoms a foot long or more) lining the trail. Darwin's finches, hawks, flycatchers, and many other birds provide a natural soundtrack to your otherworldly hike. After refueling over a leisurely lunch at our friends' private hacienda, you'll have time in the late afternoon to relax by the beach with the local colony of sea lions or stroll through the laid-back beach town, soaking up the authentic island life.

#### DAY 7 »

# Isabela Island - In the Footsteps of Darwin

This morning, you'll follow in the footsteps of Charles Darwin himself as you explore Isabela Island, the legendary naturalist's final stop in the Galapagos before he set sail for Tahiti aboard the HMS Beagle in 1835. It was here that Darwin collected many of the species that would later form the foundation of his groundbreaking research on evolution.

Your day begins with a stroll to the dock, where your snorkeling gear – masks, snorkels, flippers, and wetsuits – awaits, perfectly fitted and ready for adventure. Alongside your expert naturalist guide, you'll board a panga (a comfortable flat-bottom fishing boat) and set course for Las Tintoreras, a cluster of small islets that are home to one of the few Galapagos penguin colonies in the world.

As you approach, you'll quickly discover that these curious creatures are unafraid of human visitors, making them nearly foolproof subjects for your camera lens. Observe them lounging on

the lava rocks, soaking up the equatorial sun, or grab your snorkeling gear and waterproof camera to witness these remarkable birds diving and swimming in the crystal-clear waters of the lagoon – a genuinely incredible experience. The lagoon is a haven for an array of marine life, from graceful green sea turtles and vividly colored reef fish to the fearsome-looking yet utterly harmless marine iguanas that bask on the rocks, their prehistoric forms adding to the sense of having stepped back in time.

In the afternoon, join your guides on a trail that showcases the Galapagos' incredible diversity of landscapes and wildlife. Your path winds past white sand beaches, wetlands teeming with pink flamingos, otherworldly lava formations, and mangrove forests where giant land tortoises roam. Just as Darwin did nearly two centuries ago, you'll have the opportunity to witness the iconic blue-footed boobies, frigate birds, iguanas, and the famous finches that helped inspire his theory of evolution.

Cap off this adventurous day with a hands-on culinary experience, learning the art of cevichemaking. This beloved island dish, made with freshly caught fish, is a favorite among Galapagueños, and you'll have the chance to slice, marinate, and balance the flavors and textures like a true islander before savoring your creation during dinner.

#### DAY 8 »

### Quito - Homeward Bound

After an unforgettable journey through the Galapagos Islands, you'll make your way first to Baltra Island and then to the mainland. No doubt, you'll carry memories of nature's unparalleled splendor in the world's best wildlife experience.
