### Terrain

Easy to moderate on good trails and coastal paths. An average of 2 to 3 hours of walking per day, with a vehicle usually in support. Walks around Mt. Etna are moderate and involve some elevation gains and losses over loose lava rocks and gravel.

DAY 1 »

### **Palermo**

You'll begin in sunny Palermo at your hotel, located in the heart of the ancient city. Very nearby is Mount Pellegrino. Join your guide for a walk that seamlessly blends history, nature, and breathtaking views. You'll start at the Santuario di Santa Rosalia, a cave church on the mountain dedicated to the city's patron saint who lived in a little hermitage there in the Middle Ages.

As you walk, the air is filled with the scent of Mediterranean pine trees. Keep an eye out for colorful butterflies fluttering among the flowers and the chirping of local birds that call this urban oasis their home. Not only does the Scala Vecchia trail provide an excellent immersion into the history and culture of the island, it offers stunning panoramic views of the city's terracotta rooftops juxtaposed against the Mediterranean Sea.

Later in the afternoon, return to town to explore Palermo's historical center on foot at eye level, on a guided walk that includes colorful piazzas and courtyards. You'll arrive at the hotel to relax before savoring a delicious dinner of traditional Sicilian specialties.

DAY 2 »

# Regaleali / Agrigento

As you travel into the heart of Sicily, the warm Mediterranean sun glistens off the olive groves, vineyards and wheat fields that are the breadbasket that has fed ages of civilizations. Here, in the Regaleali area, one of our close friends invites you into her kitchen for an 'only with Classic Journeys' experience — an opportunity to put on an apron, roll up your sleeves and pour a glass of the local wine while you enjoy a cooking instruction with her. After savoring the memorable lunch that you helped to create, stretch your legs on a scenic walk through the rolling countryside surrounding your hosts' home.

Later, head to Agrigento where the Valle dei Templi (Valley of the Temples) is located on a plateau outside of town. Your hotel is perfectly sited with views of the archeological zone and a cinematic benefit of staying here is the opportunity to dine al fresco on the terrace with a temple illuminated against the night sky as the scenic backdrop to your meal.

DAY 3 »

### Agrigento

Wake up this morning and prepare for the magnificent sight of the best-preserved Greek temples in Italy. If you're an early riser, watch the light of the morning sun as it bathes one of the temples in a golden glow. Following breakfast, you'll approach them in the best way: on foot at eye level. Your scenic walk offers stunning landscapes and a deep connection to the ancient past, making it a must for history buffs and nature lovers. Along the way, groves of olive trees with their gnarled trunks and silvery leaves line the way. Fragrant scents of thyme, rosemary, and oregano fill the air. Ancient stone walls reveal the rich agricultural practices that sustained the people who once inhabited the land. And the crowning jewels of the walk are the temples, some dating to 440 BC: Jupiter, Concordia, Hercules, Dioscuri, Castor and Pollux.

After lunch, you'll enjoy a true 'only with Classic Journeys' experience as you meet three generations of a family on their country estate. Picture yourself walking up to a little countryside house where a smiling nonna is waiting with glasses of lemon ice. Refreshed, continue on to meet one of her granddaughters, Giulia, who leads you on a walk through the olive trees explaining all the ins and outs of olives, olive oil, farming, producing, and pressing. Cap the visit with a tasting of several of the family's olive oils.

#### DAY 4 »

### **Taormina**

As you make your way from Agrigento to Taormina, the landscape unfolds like a tapestry of all that has made Sicily so iconic and desirable to civilizations of people. The air is filled with the sweet fragrance of citrus blossoms from orange groves originally planted by the Moors during Arab rule. And the vineyards you pass through showcase ancient winemaking traditions that date to Greek and Roman times.

As you walk through one of the vineyards, a winemaker greets you for a fascinating and immersive day of exploration, showcasing the warmth and hospitality of the locals. Our friends invite you to their organic winery, renowned for producing acclaimed wines. The volcanic soil in this part of the island is ideal for grape cultivation, and the views—whether you're walking through the vineyards, gazing at the sea, admiring the coastline, or taking in Mount Etna—are truly breathtaking.

Mid-afternoon, arrive in Taormina and you'll understand immediately the town's allure to thousands of years of travelers. Perched on cliffs overlooking the Ionian Sea, Taormina rivals the charm of Positano on the Amalfi Coast. Its picturesque setting has attracted artists, writers, and travelers for centuries. With your guide, walk the cobblestoned streets through the heart of Taormina. The main corso, connecting the two ancient entrance gates, is lined with elegant boutiques, antique shops and trattorias. Wind down this afternoon over an Aperol Spritz, enjoying some people watching as the locals go about their daily lives and you feel yourself settling into the tempo of village life.

#### DAY 5 »

### Mt. Etna

In the distance, the silhouette of Mt. Etna, Europe's highest and most active volcano, dominates the horizon. This majestic peak, often snowcapped, adds a dramatic backdrop to the small villages and towns, each with its own unique stories and anecdotes that your guide shares with you, bringing them to life. After breakfast, make a short journey to Mt. Etna, one of the world's major active volcanoes and, at 10,958 feet, the highest in Europe. Starting from an altitude of about 7,000 feet, set out on an otherworldly walk on a scenic pathway over and along lava rivers that provide the opportunity to experience firsthand the incredible volcanic formations created over the last several centuries.

Midday you'll be greeted at a mountain refuge with a rustic lunch of goat cheese, bruschetta, sun-dried tomatoes, Italian sausages, lamb and homemade pastas, accompanied by the excellent red Etna wine grown right on the same slopes. Fortified from lunch, head back to Taormina through the charming village of Linguaglossa — which, in the winter, is a busy ski resort.

In the afternoon, explore Taormina on your own and rummage around the Borgo Medievale (the oldest and most colorful part of town) that allows you to see what everyone from the ancient Greeks to DH Lawrence and Goethe have seen in its spectacular location. You might opt to visit the Public Gardens, with its exotic flowers and eccentric follies. Or you might prefer to relax at the hotel, lounge by the pool or enjoy a drink on the spectacular terrace before dinner.

### DAY 6 »

# Taormina / Catania

### DAILY ITINERARY SICILY | CULTURAL WALKING TOUR

A morning walk leads to the crown jewel of Taormina, its ancient Greek theater, a marvel of engineering and design. Originally built in the 3rd century for dramatic and musical performances, the theater later served as an arena for Roman games and gladiator battles. The panoramic views from the theater, framed by the sea and Etna, create a mesmerizing backdrop for any performance, including those you can see even present day by the likes of Sting and other artists. Unlike many ancient sites, Taormina has managed to balance its historical side while also becoming a contemporary cultural icon. The town has gained modern fame as the backdrop for the TV series 'White Lotus' and this juxtaposition of ancient history and pop culture adds a layer of fascination to the town's identity and your experiences here.

The balance of the morning is yours to relax, swim and explore the quaint streets of the colorful town with bougainvillea laced along the medieval buildings. Late morning, drive to Catania to part company at the airport for flights back to mainland Italy.
